ADVISORY TO REGISTRANTS

The Trinidad and Tobago Securities and Exchange Commission advises that the United Nations Security Council updated the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List, on August 18, 2017, to include Trinidadian national, Mr. Shane Dominic Crawford.

The ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee listed Mr. Crawford as being associated with ISIL or Al-Qaida for:

- "participating in the financing, planning, facilitating, preparing, or perpetrating of acts or activities by, in conjunction with, under the name of, on behalf of, or in support of";
- "recruiting for";
- "otherwise supporting acts or activities of": and
- "other acts or activities indicating association with"

Islamic State in Iraq and the Levant (ISIL), listed as Al-Qaida in Iraq (QDe.115).
